BASIC OPERATIONS FIREFIGHTER / NFPA FIREFIGHTER I BLENDED

The Basic Operations Firefighter / NFPA Firefighter I Blended course gives firefighters the practical and cognitive training needed to operate safely on the fireground. The 18-week course is delivered through a unique and flexible schedule format featuring 9 practical weekend sessions and online learning. Students complete the coursework through an instructor supported online classroom. Practical weekend sessions are offered simultaneously across the state, eliminating a need for students to travel long distances to complete the training. Upon successful completion of all course requirements, students will also meet Illinois OSFM, Pro Board, and IFSAC NFPA Firefighter I requirements for certification.



Training for the Basic Operations Firefighter/NFPA Firefighter I Blended program is funded by the Office of the State Fire Marshal (OSFM) through an appropriation of agency funds. OSFM granted these funds for the purpose of supporting basic firefighter certification.






