COLONA FIREFIGHTERS OFF DUTY RESPONSIBILITIES DURING THIS TIME OF CRISIS

TRAVEL-EXPOSURE-QUARANTINE YOURSELF POLICY

1. Use personal hygiene practices everywhere you go. (CDC Directives)
2. Personal contact should be at least 6 ft. away face to face. No personal contact (besides family members). If you or family members are sick or exposed with flue like symptoms restrict yourself from emergency calls. This doesn't mean you have COVIR-19
3. VERY IMPORTANT: Travel: If you are leaving the Quad-Cities area for vacation, business, recreation, or family activities we need to know certain things. We would like to know before you go, where, how long you are going to be gone and when you plan on returning. We need this before you return to active duty. After you return please be cleared by Deputy Chief's. The main reason for this is to inform you of a possible outbreak in this area or where you were, so you may need to be evaluated.
4. If you are receiving visitors or other people from out of town that is not from the Quad-City area. Document where they reside and contact information and again use CDC recommendations.
5. Exposure: If you feel you have been exposed to a virus and not protected, or were protected you still need to go through decon procedures, please quarantine yourself in place for proper decon procedures. Please contact command for directives. **DO NOT SPREAD DISEASE**

At this point your biggest risks or exposure to any virus is where, what and how you are conducting normal activities outside the fire house. These are universal precautions you can take and highly recommend following CDC (Center for Disease Control)

COMMUNICATION WILL BE THE KEY TO MITIGATE ANY SITUATION
