Course Syllabus

Course Title: Community Risk Reduction - Assessment

Course Duration: 16 Hours

Program: Fire Prevention

Course Prerequisites: None

Course Description:

This course will focus on the Community Risk Reduction (CRR) steps involved in identifying and prioritizing risks, and the processes required for conducting a risk assessment in preparation for prevention and mitigation planning. The intent is to provide simple and easily understood guidelines for fire departments and/or other agencies to conduct a risk assessment of their community, with the goal of developing a local CRR program.

Course Requirements:

Module: 5 Title: Putting It All Together - Community Risk Reduction Model <u>Terminal Learning Objective:</u> At the conclusion of this module, the student will practice working on a community risk assessment.

Module: 6 Title: Practical Application of Assessment Process <u>Terminal Learning Objective:</u> At the conclusion of this module, the student will complete a community risk assessment.
