Course Description: Firefighter Type 1, S-131, is an eight-hour course designed to meet the training needs of the Firefighter Type 1 (FFT1). This course is designed to be interactive in nature. Topics include fireline reference materials, communications, and tactical decision making

(Post-Course Work)

Exercise evaluations will depend on each student's ability to follow standard operating procedures, make decisions, and communicate instructions and/or actions to the appropriate team members during the exercise.
