Course Syllabus

Course Title: Acquired Structure Burn Team Member Training

Course Duration: 8 hours

Program: Fire Fighting

Course Prerequisites: Acquired Structure (House) Burn

Course Description: An acquired structure burn is a unique opportunity for fire fighters to learn new skills, as well as to hone previously acquired abilities. As a result, this course has been designed for approved IFSI Instructors to become a member of the IFSI Acquired Structure Burn Team. Topics covered will include NFPA 1403 policies and IFSI Acquired Structure Policies and Procedures. Drills and scenarios will replicate an Acquired Structure Live Burn.

Course Requirements:

Pre-Course Work: Complete the online Acquired Structure Training

Course Work: Participate in the lecture and all drills

Post-Course Work: Complete the Burn Team Member Task Book

Course Policies:

Safety Policy: Students shall understand and follow all instructions pertaining to operational safety, as stated by instructors or as written in course materials. Instructors and students shall be mindful of safety at all times. Conduct judged to be unsafe shall be grounds for dismissal from the course.
