

# Program of Instruction

## Course Syllabus

**Course Title:** Light and Fight

**Course Duration:** 8 Hours

**Program:** Firefighting Program

**Course Prerequisites:** None

### **Course Description:**

The Light and Fight is designed for entry-level firefighters seeking hands-on instruction, or more experienced firefighters looking for live fire experience. Light and Fights provide a full day of live-fire training, with instruction provided entirely by IFSI staff. Students rotate through a variety of skill stations, which emphasize SCBA, hose movement, ladder work and forcible entry. These stations are designed to allow students to practice and develop their Firefighter II level skills. IFSI staff develops the objectives and drills for the day.

Students can correlate their completed Light and Fight objectives with their OSFM Firefighter II objectives.

### **Course Requirements and/or Recommendations:**

Students shall have 100% participation of the Light and Fight. In addition to participation in the drill, students shall participate in the clean-up and set-up of all drill stations and site at the end of the training day.
